What do the icons on the front and back of the device mean?

HSPA (Mobile Broadband) Indicator

-	Off	The HSPA module is not connected or used.
Red	Blinking slowly	The HSPA connection is normal and data connection is being established.
Red	Blinking quickly	The HSPA connection is normal and voice connection is being established.

Wi-Fi Indicator

-	Off	The Wi-Fi network is not activated.
Red	Blinking slowly	The Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) process is in progress.
Red	On	The Wi-Fi connection is in good condition.
Red	Blinking quickly	The Wi-Fi connection is normal and data is being transmitted on the link.

DSL Indicator

-	Off	The ADSL connection is not activated.
Red	Blinking slowly	The ADSL connection is in process.
Red	On	The ADSL connection is in good condition.
Red	Blinking quickly	ADSL synchronisation is in progress.

Power Indicator

-	Off	The Vodafone Broadband Complete is powered off.
Red	On	The Vodafone Broadband Complete is powered on.

LAN Indicator

-	Off	There is no Ethernet connection.
Green	On	The Ethernet connection is in good condition.
Red	On	The LAN connection is not connected.

You should also make sure that you have the items listed opposite ready.

Setting up your Vodafone Broadband Complete

1. The Power adapter

Connect the supplied **power adapter** to the power port and plug it into a mains wall outlet or a power strip.

Once the device is connected, the power indicator on the front of your device will light up.

2. The Line filter and DSL cable

Connect the supplied **DSL cable** from the **modem DSL port** to the **line filter ADSL port**. Then plug the line filter into your phone wall socket.

You can also plug in a phone if required to the phone port of the line filter. Note: All phones in use are required to be plugged into a line filter. Do not connect your phone or fax directly to the Broadband Complete device.

3. The PC/LAN cable

Connect the supplied **PC/LAN** cable to any one of the four LAN ports and plug the other end into the Ethernet port on your computer.

4. Getting online

Your Broadband Complete modem will now connect to the Vodafone network and be automatically configured with your new Vodafone settings.

As soon as your modem has been successfully configured, a confirmation webpage will appear. It can take up to 5 minutes to complete this process.

From this page you'll be able to download and install our free **Broadband Assistant** to help you solve common connection issues should they arise. You can also use this tool to set up your wireless connection and your email.



5. To set up your wireless connection

By default, wireless broadband is already enabled. Use your computer's wireless software to find and connect to your Broadband Complete modem. It will appear on your computer using the **SSID name which is listed on the rear panel** of your device.

You will then be prompted to enter the **WPA key also listed on the rear panel** of your device to secure your wireless connection.

6. Accessing the Broadband Complete management interface

Open up your web browser (i.e. Internet Explorer) and enter **http://192.168.1.1** into the address bar and press **Enter**.

A **pop up box will appear** that will allow you to login to the management interface using the following details.

Username: **vodafone**
Password: **vodafone**

You'll then be logged into the Broadband Complete home page.

7. Make the most of your Broadband Complete

You can connect your printer or external hard drive directly to the Broadband Complete modem to print and access files. For help setting up these features, refer to the full manual on the CD you received with your hardware.

You can also enable DLNA which allows you to plug an external hard drive into your Broadband Complete modem and share any media content on that drive with your home network and any other DLNA compatible devices, such as Sony's Playstation 3.
