# 1 SETTING UP THE GPRS DATA ACCOUNT



## Setting up the GPRS Data Account

It is important this data account is created first.

This data account allows the phone (when used with a PC) to access the Internet via Vodafone. The email client also uses this.

- Push Start, scroll down to Settings, or press 8
- This will take you to the settings menu.
- Scroll down to More, or press 9
- Scroll down to Data Connections, or press 2
- Press the Menu button (on the left hand side), then select Edit Connections, or press 1
- Scroll down to GPRS Connections, or press 4
- Press the Menu button, select Add, or press 1
- Under Description type in VF GPRS
- Under Connects To select: The Internet
- In Access Point type in: www.vodafone.net.nz
- All other details may be left blank
- Select Done
- Your GPRS account has now been created

# 2 SETTING UP THE EMAIL ACCOUNT



## Setting up an email account

You will need to consult your email provider for incoming, or pop server information

- Push the Start button (on the left hand side)
- Go to Inbox and press the nav key, or press 1
- Press the Menu button, select Options, or press 8
- Scroll down to Account set up, or press 5
- Press the Menu button (right hand side) then select New, or press 1
- Fill in the following details:

Your Name	Name that will be displayed when you send a message
Email Address	Your email address

- Under Automatic Set up click the Nav button to untick the Automatic setup button
- Click Next button, (right hand side)

User name	Your email login name
Password	Your email password

- Tick save password box to save password, otherwise leave unticked (you will have to manually input your password every time you check/send messages)
- Click Next button, (right hand side)

Server type	Pop3, or IMAP (check with your provider if unsure)
Account name	The name of your provider
Network	The Internet

- Click Next button, (right hand side)

Incoming mail server	Check with your provider for details
Outgoing mail server	smtp.vodafone.net.nz

- Outgoing server requires authentication should be unticked
- Require SSL connection should be unticked
- Click Next button, (right hand side)
- Select your downloading options
- Click Next button, (right hand side)
- **!!Connect automatically and check for messages: This should be set to Never!!**

Any other option will cause the phone to automatically connect to the network and check for messages, resulting in GPRS charges.

- Click Next button, (right hand side)
- Click Finish button, (right hand side)

#### MMS Setup

Set up the MMS data account

- Press the Start menu, scroll down to Settings, or press 8
- Scroll down to More, or press 9
- Scroll down to Data Connections, or press 2
- Scroll down to Secure WAP connection, press Menu, select Edit Connections or press 1
- Scroll down to GPRS Connections, or press 4
- Press the Menu button, then select Add or press 1

Connects to:	Secure WAP Network
Access Point	live.vodafone.com
Description	Voda PXT

Leave all other fields blank

- Press Done
- Press the Home key (left hand side)
- Press the Start menu, scroll down to Settings, or press 8
- Scroll down to More, or press 9
- Scroll down to Data Connections, or press 2
- Scroll down to Secure WAP connection, select Voda PXT
- Press Done

MMS set up

From standby screen

- Press the Start button Scroll down to more, or press 9
- Scroll down to Pxt, or press 6
- Scroll down to Settings or press 6
- Scroll down to Connect via, select Secure WAP Network
- Press Menu highlight, MMSC settings, or press 1
- Press Menu and select New, or press 1

- Press Done

### Setting up the Internet Data Account

Internet set up

Ensure that the GPRS data account is already set up.

- Push Start, scroll down to Settings, or press 8
- This will take you to the settings menu.
- Scroll down to more, or press 9
- Scroll down to Data Connections, or press 2
- Under Internet connection select VF GPRS, Press Done
- Go to standby screen
- Press the Start button
- Scroll down to Internet Explorer, or press 4
- Press the Menu button, then scroll down to Options, or press 7
- Scroll down to Connections and press the Nav Key
- Automatically detect settings box can be unticked
- Under Select Network select The Internet
- Press Done

Please note:

To connect, you will also need to have a GPRS plan setup on your account. All new Prepay and On Account connections have the GPRS OMB plan by default. Other plans available to On Account customers.
