Setting up the Internet Data Account

It is important this data account is created first.

This data account allows the phone (when used with a PC) to access the Internet via Vodafone. The email client also uses this.

- Open the flip on the phone to allow access to the full menu.
- Click the **Control Panel** icon from the list of icons at the top.
- Click the **Connections** tab.
- Click **Internet Accounts**.
- Click the **New** button to start creating a new connection.
- The **Internet Account** window will open.
- **Account Name** will be displayed.
- Enter **GPRS Internet**.
- **Connection Type** will be displayed.
- Select **GPRS** from the drop down box.
- Click on the **Advanced** button and then on the Click on the **Server** tab.
- Under the **Server** tab the **User Name and Password Required** leave unticked.
- In the **Address** field type in www.vodafone.net.nz.
- Click on the **Login** tab.
- Under the **Login** tab the box **Get IP Address Automatically** should be ticked.
- Scroll down, and then tick the **Get DNS Address Automatically** box.
- Under the **Proxy** tab leave blank
- Under **Other** tab Enable PPP extensions and Authentication set to normal.
- Under the **Qos** tab.

Setting up the WAP Data Account

This data account allows the phone access WAP sites via Vodafone.

This phone does not have a WAP browser, but WAP pages can be displayed using the Internet browser.

- Click the **Control Panel** icon from the main menu.
- Click the **Connections** tab.
- Select **WAP Accounts** at the bottom of the list.
- Select the **New** button.
- In the **Account Name** box type in **VF WAP GPRS**.
- **Account Name** will be displayed.
- Enter **GPRS Internet**.
- **Connection Type** will be displayed.
- Select **GPRS** from the drop down box.
- Click on the **Advanced** button and then on the Click on the **Server** tab.
- Under the **Server** tab the **User Name and Password Required** leave unticked.
- In the **Address** field type in live.vodafone.com
- Click on the **Login** tab.
- Under the **Login** tab the box **Get IP Address Automatically** should be ticked.
- Scroll down, and then tick the **Get DNS Address Automatically** box.
- Under the **Proxy** tab leave blank
- Under **Other** tab Enable PPP extensions and Authentication set to normal.
- Under the **Qos** tab.

- **Press done twice**

To browse a WAP site open up the **Internet Explorer** under **Applications**. Select **Internet** from the top toolbar. Select **Open Page**, and then enter in the WAP URL you wish to browse. Also you can choose bookmarks – Internet then new bookmark.

STARTING AN INTERNET SESSION



- Quick Start: Press the Silver Button on the side of the phone. This will launch the homepage setup in the phone.

Press this button with flip open

- Open the flip and click the **Applications** icon from the list at the top (located on the far right.)
- Select the **Internet** icon.
- The Internet browser will open.

To view a specific page:

- Click on **Internet** from the toolbar at the top.
- Select the option **Open Page**, this will allow you to then type in an Internet address or click on bookmarks.

Setting up a GPRS Data Account

It is important this data account is created first.

This data account allows the phone (when used with a PC) to access the Internet via Vodafone. The email client also uses this.

- Click the **Control Panel** icon from the list of icons at the top.
- Select the **Connections** tab.
- Select **Messaging Accounts**.
- The **Email Accounts** window will appear.
- Make sure that the **Email** tab is selected (it should be by default.)
- Click the **New** button to start a new account.
- Click the on the **Basic** tab.
- Under the **Basic** tab you will be able to enter in your **Account Name**, **Your Name**, and **Email Address** details.
- Under **Connection Type** select **POP3 or IMAP** from the drop down box.
- Select **Preferred account (GPRS Internet)** from the **Internet Account** drop down box.
- Click the on the **Inbox** tab.
- In the **User Name** box type your username. This will normally be the first part of your email address.
- In the **Password** box type your password. Please note that both the username and password fields may be case sensitive.
- In the **Incoming Server** address field type in the incoming email server of your email provider. Example pop3.vodafone.net.nz
- **Download Settings** set to just headers or can be set to your personal preference.
- **Schedule Settings** should have **Scheduled Download** deactivated.
- Click the on the **Outbox** tab.
- In the **Outgoing Server Address** field type **smtp.vodafone.net.nz**.
- **User SMTP Authentication** should be disabled.
- Click the on the **Advanced** tab.
- **Secure Connection** should be disabled.
- **Outgoing Mail Port** should be set to **25**.
- **Use MIME Encoding** can be set to on.
- **Incoming Mail Port** should be set to **110**.
- **Secure Password Authentication** should be disabled.
- Click **Done**.

To access you email account, click the **Messages** icon from the list at the top. Your email account name should now be displayed next to an icon of an envelope with and @ in the corner. Click on the envelope then on Get&send to access your email.

MMS Setup

- Click the **Control Panel** icon from the list of icons at the top then click the **Connections** tab.
- Click **Internet Accounts** then click the **New** button to start creating a new connection.
- The **Internet Account** window will open and **Account Name** will be displayed. Enter **Vodafone MMS PXT**.
- **Connection Type** will be displayed and select **GPRS** from the drop down box. Click on the **Advanced** button.
- Click on the **Server** tab.
- Under the **Server** tab the **User Name and Password Required** box left to un-ticked.
- In the **Address** field type in **live.vodafone.com**.
- Click on the **Login** tab.
- Under the **Login** tab the box **Get IP Address Automatically** should be ticked.
- Scroll down the page and make sure the **Get Primary and Secondary DNS Address Automatically** box is ticked.
- Click on the **Proxy** tab.
- The **Use Proxy Server** box should be unticked.
- Click the **Other** tab, the **Enable PPP Extensions** box should be unticked.
- **Authentication** should be set to **Normal**.
- Under the **Qos** tab.

- **Press done three times**
- Return to the main menu.
- Select the **Control Panel** icon from the list of icons at the top then select the **Connections** tab.
- Select **WAP Accounts**. In the **WAP Accounts** window select **New**.
- In the **Account Name** box type in **Vodafone MMS PXT**.
- Under the **Internet Account** drop down box select **Vodafone MMS**.
- Tick the **Use Proxy** box.
- In the address field type **172.030.038.003**.
- In the **Port** field type **9201**.
- The **Username** and **Password** field can be left blank.
- Click **Done** then select the **Preferred** tab.
- Tick the **Use WAP Account** box.
- Under the **Preferred** drop down box select **VF WAP GPRS** then click **Done**.
- Return to the main menu.
- Select the **Control Panel** icon from the list of icons at the top and select the **Connections** tab.
- Select **Messaging Accounts**.
- Select the **MMS** tab.
- Under **Service Centre Address** enter <http://pxt.vodafone.net.nz/pxtsend>.
- Under **WAP Account** select **Vodafone MMS PXT**.
- Set **Automatic** to **Off**.
- Set **Download Size** to **No restrict**.
- Click the **Advanced** button.
- Click the **Send** tab.
- Set the **Validity Period** to **Maximum**.
- Set **Priority** to **Normal**.
- Leave all the other boxes un-ticked.
- **Click the Receive tab.**

Play:	ticked
Allow delivery notification:	ticked
Allow read notification:	ticked
Exclude:	Leave the rest of the boxes un-ticked.
- Click **Done** twice and then exit to the main screen and that's it.
