## Setting up your phone

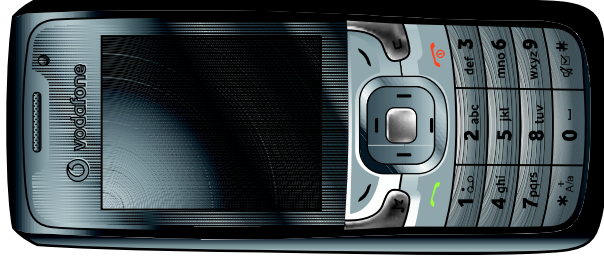
Before you can start exploring your new phone, you'll need to set it up.

- Insert your Vodafone SIM card as shown. Make sure the gold contacts and the cut-off corner are positioned correctly.
- Replace the battery as shown, and charge it if necessary. See the User Guide for full details on charging.
- Insert a memory card as shown (if one is supplied). This increases the phone's memory.
- Press and hold the  key to turn it on (or off).



## What the keys do

-  The navigation key. In the Home screen, press it in  to open the main **Menu**. Press it up  for **Vodafone live!**  for **My Files**, down  for **Contacts**, and left  for **New text message**.
-  The Call key makes and answers calls. In the Home screen, it opens **Call history**.
-  The End key ends calls. Press it to return to the Home screen.
-  The soft keys select the options on the bottom left or right of the screen.
-  The Clear key. Deletes text and numbers.
-  The Music player key. This also starts video calls.

## Entering text

*Different phones sometimes use different ways of entering text. but it doesn't take long to get used to it.*

### Switching text entry modes

- Press the **0** key for a space.
- To switch between predictive text [T9] and multi tap [T9], press the **☰** key.

- Pressing the **☰** key cycles through the different upper and lower case options in the text entry modes, and also the number mode [123].

### Predictive text

- If you're happy with a word or letter combination, press the navigation key **➡** to OK it.
- To see the other word or letter options, press the **▼** key.

### Symbols and numbers

- Press the **1** key for commonly-used symbols.

## Other differences

Here are some more differences you may find between this phone and your last one.

### Turn silent mode on

To switch to silent (vibrate only) mode, press and hold the **[\*]** key when you're in the Home screen. To turn your ringer/notifications back on, press and hold **[\*]** again.

### Lock the keys

To lock the keys, press and hold the **[\*]** key when you're in the Home screen. To unlock them, press **[\*]** and then the center key **[0]**.

### 3G (also known as UMTS)

The Vodafone 3G network is completely new, faster mobile network. As well as letting you make video calls, you also find that downloads are significantly quicker, and music can be streamed straight to

your phone, and browsing in Media is quick and the mobile internet should be much swifter.

So you can do a lot more in the few minutes before the train arrives.

- To find out if you're in a 3G area, look for the 3G symbol **[3G]** in the upper menu bar of the screen.
- You'll also be able to use an existing 2.5G network at a lot of other times.

## Making voice and video calls

- Please note that this phone shows your video caller the view from the camera on the back. This is sometimes called 'See What I See'.

- During a video call you'll automatically be on speakerphone.



### Adjust a video call

Press **Options** for settings and other options, such as swapping screens, and turning the camera on and off.


### Answer a call

- Press the  key.
- You'll see an on-screen alert if there's an incoming video call.

### Choose a contact or enter a number

- Press  to open your contacts list, and choose a number to call (it must be a 3G mobile number to receive a video call, and you must be in a 3G area).
- Press the  key. This opens your call history, so you can choose a recent number.
- Enter a number using the keypad.

### Make a voice or video call

- Press the  key to make a voice call.
- Press the  key or **Options > Video call** to make a video call. If the 3G network isn't available, you can choose to make a voice call instead.

## Using the camera

### How many times have you thought 'if only I had a camera with me?'

Amazing things happen around us every day. With your phone's camera, now it's easy to capture the moment. And it's just as easy to share it.

#### Turn the camera on

Simply press the camera key  on the side of the phone, or go to **Menu > Entertainment > Camera** from the Home screen.

- Press the navigation key  to zoom in and out. Hold that zoom key to view a larger or smaller resolution.

#### Take a photo

- Press the camera key .
- The photo will be taken and saved to **Menu > My Files > Pictures**.



- Press  or **Options > Delete** to delete it. Press **Back** to take another photo.

#### Send your photo

You can send your photo in a message to another mobile, or to an email address. See the **Messaging** section for more details.

- Press **Options > Send**.



### Camera settings

- Use the ◀▶ keys to change the brightness.
- Use the side volume keys to adjust the contrast.
- To change other settings, press **Options**.
- Large photo sizes may be automatically resized when sending in a message.



- Press **Options** > **Go to gallery** to play it.

- You can then send your video by pressing **Options** > **Send** > **As PXT**, or press **Send** to record another one.

### Video settings

- To change other settings, press **Options**. Videos are saved in **Menu** > **My Files** > **Videos**.



### Take a video

- To turn on the video recorder, press **Options** > **Video camera** if you're already in camera mode.
- Press the camera key or **Start** to start recording, and press **Stop** to stop.



# Sending messages

The best time to share your thoughts, photos and videos is now.

Creating a multimedia message (PXT) is just like writing a text message – but you can add photos, videos or sounds as well. So now you can show as well as tell...

## Text messaging (SMS)

- Press **◀** in the Home screen to send a new text message.
- Write your message using the keypad. When you're finished, press **⏏**.
- Enter the mobile number you're sending it to, or choose a Contact number by pressing **Options > Contacts**.
- Press **⏏** to send it.

## Multimedia messaging (PXT)

- Go to **Menu > Messaging > Write PXT**.

You can choose to send an PXT to a mobile number or an email address.

- Press **⏏** [**<To>**]. Then press **Options > Contact** to choose a mobile number or email address from your contacts, or press **⏏** again to enter a number or address.
- Press **Back** to return to the PXT screen, then press **▼** until you highlight [**<Content>**].
- Press **⏏** twice, and write your message using the keypad. When you're finished, press **⏏**.
- Press **▼** to select the type of sound to add. Then press **⏏**.
- Select a photo, sound or video clip from **My Files**, then press **Confirm**. **Note:** if you add a video clip then you may not be able to add anything else.

- To see how your message will appear, press **Options** > **Preview**.
- To delete anything, press **Options** > **Remove object**.
- Press **Back** to return to the main PXT screen, then press **Options** > **Send**.

**Note:**

- If you don't know the address of your phone, and you're using "See you later...", you'll need to enter the PXT to someone whose mobile isn't PXT compatible. They'll be sent a web address that they can view your message on.
- To view your messages, go to **Menu** > **Messaging** > **SMS** or **PXT**.
- To send and receive emails on your phone, please see the User Guide.



## Exploring Vodafone live!

Now you don't need to wait until you get home to find **cool stuff** on the web.

Vodafone live! is your mobile page on the mobile internet. In most cases, it's free to look for, and you'll find everything from news, sport, and local hot downloads, music and TV gossip there.

The simplest way to see how it works is just to browse around it.

### Connect to Vodafone live!

- Simply press **[\*]** **live!** in the Home screen.
- To open a link, select it and press **[\*]**.
- To go back to a previous page, press **Back**.
- To go to a new page, press **Options** > **Enter URL**.
- To go to Vodafone live!, press **[\*]**.

### Use bookmarks

You can save and revisit pages, just like a web browser.

- To save a page, press **Options** > **Save page**.
- To go to a saved page, press **Options** > **Saved pages**.
- To see your bookmarks without connecting, go to the **Menu** > **Vodafone live!** > **Bookmarks**.

**Note:** when you're in a 3G area, you should also find that you have even more to choose from.

## Downloading stuff

Make your phone **all your own** by downloading new ringtones, games, music, wallpapers and more.

You can either download stuff while browsing Vodafone live!, or by using your phone's built-in links. Either way, the process is simple, as any charges are billed to your phone.

Don't worry, you'll always see how much it is, and you'll always be asked to confirm that you want to go ahead.

### Download from a built-in link

Each folder in **My Files** contains links to the appropriate download's section in Vodafone live!.

For example, to download a new ringtone:

- Open the main **Menu > My Files > Ringtones**.
- Select **Download ringtones**, then choose a ringtone to download from the thousands available. You'll usually

be billed to your bill.

- Follow the onscreen instructions to download it. It will be saved on your phone in **My Files > Ringtones**.

### Use your download

- Find your download in **My Files**, and then highlight it.
- To set a sound as your new ringtone, highlight it and press **Options > Set as ringtone > Voice Call**.
- To set a picture as your new background wallpaper, highlight it and press **Options > Set as > Wallpaper**.

## Other features and services

- Find out about a few other things you can do with your phone that you might not discover otherwise.
- Open a playlist, then press **Options** > **Add**, and add the tracks you want.
  - Choose your playlist and press **Options** > **Play**.

### Vodafone Full Track Music Downloads

Now you can download music whenever you want. Go to **My Files** > **Music** > **Download music**. Choose from a huge selection of current and classic tracks. Only in a 3G area.

### Music player

Your phone is also a portable music player. You can download music from Vodafone live! or transfer it to the memory card.

- Go to **Menu** > **Music** > **Music store** to download and own more music.
- To create a new playlist, press **[F5]** or **Menu** > **Music** then **Playlist**.
